

Surah Baqara: 2:30-39

- 2:30 And when your Lord said to the angels, "I am placing a khalifa upon the earth," they said, "Will You place there one who will work corruption therein, and shed blood, while we hymn Thy praise and sanctify You?" He said, "Truly, I know what you know not.
- 2:31 And He taught Adam the names, all of them. Then He presented them to the angels and said, "Tell me the names of these, if you are truthful.
- 2:32 They said, "Glory be to You! We have no knowledge save what You have taught us. Truly You are the Knower, the Wise.
- 2:33 He said, "Adam, tell them their names." And when he had told them their names He said, "Did I not say to you that I know the unperceivable of the heavens and the earth, and that I know what you disclose and what you conceal?
- 2:34 And when We said to the angels, "Prostrate unto Adam," they prostrated, save Iblis. He refused arrogantly; he was among the disbelievers.
- 2:35 We said, "O Adam, dwell you and your wife in the Garden and eat freely thereof, wheresoever you will, but approach not this tree, lest you be among the wrongdoers.
- 2:36 Then Satan made them stumble therefrom, and caused them to be expelled from that wherein they were, and We said, "Go down, some of you an enemy to the other. On the earth is your dwelling place and provisions for a while.
- 2:37 Then Adam received words from his Lord, and He relented unto him. Indeed, He is the oft-Relenting, the Merciful
- 2:38 We said, "Go down from it, all of you. If guidance should come to you from Me, then whosoever follows My Guidance, no fear shall come upon them, nor shall they grieve.
- 2:39 But those who disbelieve and deny Our signs, it is they who are the inhabitants of the Fire, therein they shall abide forever.
